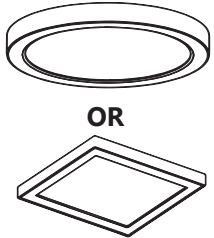


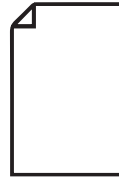

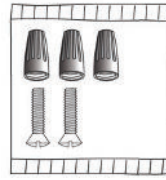

LED Ceiling Light

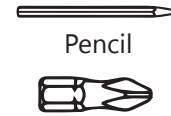

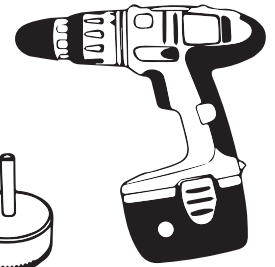

## IMPORTANT - READ ALL INSTRUCTIONS BEFORE INSTALLATION

- Installation and maintenance must be performed by a licensed electrician only.
- To avoid risk of electric shock, make sure to turn off main power switch prior to installation or maintenance.
- Must be installed in compliance with National Electrical Code (NEC) in the US or Canadian Electrical Code in Canada.
- Ensure input voltage and frequency are compatible with the fixture. Check product manual for power requirements prior to installation.

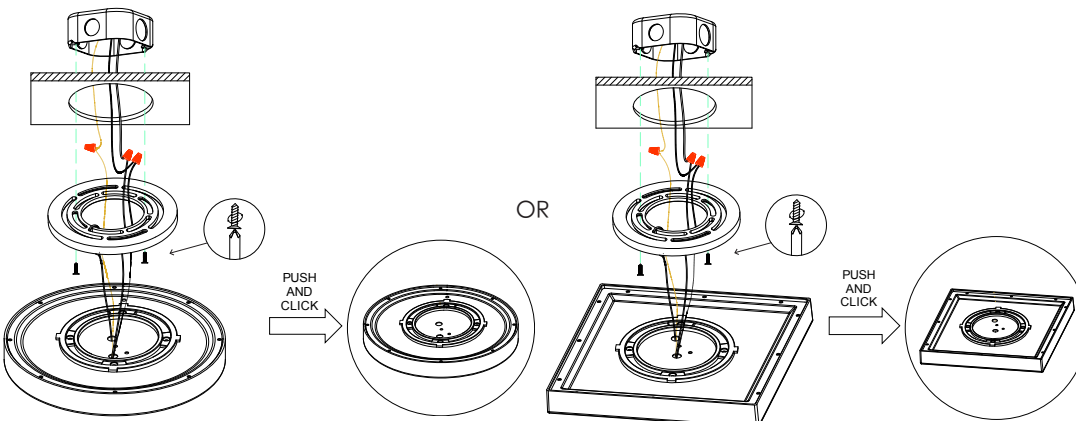
- Must be grounded

## MAINTENANCE AND CARE

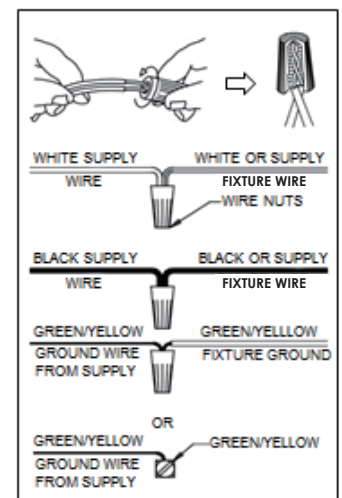
1. Clean and maintain the luminaire regularly
2. When cleaning, use a soft cloth with non-abrasive detergent and wipe dry with a clean soft cloth
3. Do not use any cleaners that contain alcohol, harsh chemicals or pesticides
4. When cleaning inside the luminaire, turn off the power, and do not spray liquid cleaner directly on the LEDs, LED driver or wiring.

## HOW TO INSTALL (MOUNTING AND ELECTRICAL)

1. Read these instructions carefully before attempting to install this product.
2. Disconnect electrical power before installing or servicing any part of this fixture.
3. Place fixture on a clean flat surface.



## WIRING GUIDE



Dimmable to 10% with most dimmers. Although this product is compatible with most common residential type dimmers, dimming performance varies from dimmer to dimmer. Dimmer settings (for dimmers with brightness range adjustments) and the number of LED modules installed on the circuit can affect dimming performance.
